CONTACT INFORMATION


- Name/Brand also known as your Instagram handle
- Bio let the user know who you are/what you do
- Email/Contact info unless you like DMs
- Website/URL for the user to learn more about your work

PURPOSE - KNOW YOUR WHY

- Engagement/Awareness
- Selling Product/Service


THEME

• Find your vibe - it should match your bio





Putting It Together CONTACT + PURPOSE + THEME











WHAT DO I POST?


COLOR PALETTE

- Keep theme in mind
- Do your best to stay with the chosen color palette
- Keep in mind the overall look of the profile
- Filter vs. No Filter pick one and stick to it
- Filters: use the same 2-3

















Keep it clean with proper spacing

If you have a lot of post copy, break it up into separate paragraphs or multiple lines










TAGS: PEOPLE

- Use the handle name = @silvrsocial
 - In PHOTO (preferred)
 - Shows in their "Photos of You" mentions
 - In COPY
 - Shows only in the description
 - Re-Post Etiquette:
 - ALWAYS give credit to original source by tagging them in the photo and copy!

TAGS: HASH

SILVRSOCIAL

- Think keywords: they can be small/specific to big/broad
- Choose 5-6: however, Instagram will allow up to 30 though you probably won't need that many




Open notes on your phone, make a list of all hashtags you want to use. FIVE periods (.) spaced down makes the pretty [ellipsis] on Instagram.

Then

Select all & cut from notes



Paste into your post as a **COMMENT**..






TOP PHOTOS COUNT

When someone new visits your profile, the first 6 or 9 photos is what they see!


YOUR TOP PHOTOS SHOULD DEPICT YOU AS A WHOLE > THEME + COLOR + VOICE
