POSITION SUMMARY

SCOPE OF POSITION

The WordPress Developer's primary responsibilities will focus on the following requirements. Additional requests may be made to support the team as necessary.

- Develops high performing and scalable custom themes and plugin applications for WordPress.
- A track record of coding pixel-perfect responsive layouts from Photoshop, or Adobe XD files.
- Build or "Theme" websites code consists primarily of the custom theme files created for each client. These files contain HTML, CSS, PHP and Javascript to create the visual and functional experience of a custom design.
- Install WordPress Plugins to extend the functionality in WordPress in order to perform site specific functions like contact forms, gallery and any needed functionality that is outside of WordPress core software.
- Conduct website performance tests, and monitor the performance of our clients' websites.
- Manage existing website updates, including but not limited to: formatting and uploading gallery images, adding new pages and posts, updating existing pages and posts, improvements for site speed and SEO, page removal and redirects, contact form creation.
- Create reusable code and add to the repository for future use.
- Ensure the technical feasibility of UI/UX designs.

- Collaborate with the design team to bridge the gap between graphical design and technical implementation.
- Collaborate with other team members including project managers, strategists, and website administrators.
